The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the I JUNIOR SHOTGUN CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE AMERICAS and II MASTER SHOTGUN CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE AMERICAS is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Official Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day). The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

### **3. Rules and Regulations**

The **I CAT JR CHAMPIONSHIP** will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations.

General Regulations, Rule 3.7.4.12 Juniors.

Athletes will remain as Juniors until the 31st December of the year in which they become 21 years of age. Any athlete born between the 1st January and the 31st December, will cease to be a Junior on the 31st December of that year. Juniors may participate in all ISSF Championships and the Olympic Games as members of their national team.

For the **II MASTER SHOTGUN CHAMPIONSHIP**, Athletes must be at least 55 years old on or before the beginning of competition on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March 2025, must have an ISSF number and must meet all other requirements detailed in this document.

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The Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the CAT to supervise the I JR CAT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOTGUN. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

## Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

## Cartridge Controls

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge **testing**. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Finals, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals.

**If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 (a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ). Rule 9.4.3.2 (d)**

## 4. Participation

### Individual Events

CAT Member Federations can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete in the Final for the medals.

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The maximum individual number of starts for Country and event are:

Junior Men	5
Junior Women	5

## Individual Master Event

CAT Member Federations can enter a maximum of three (3) athletes in the Master Event. The event will be held for both TRAP and Skeet events and have male and female categories. Athletes must be at least 55 years old on or before the beginning of competition on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March 2025, must have an ISSF number and must meet all other requirements detailed in this document. The event will not have a final. First, second and third place in the event will be determined based on the results of 125 targets shot in three days.

## Mixed Team Events

The Trap Mixed team event will be included in the Competition Schedule. Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman.

## Team Events

CAT Member Federations may enter a maximum of one (1) team per team event, consisting of three (3) athletes. The team score is considered the sum of individual scores.

In this championship, the team events will be held considering the results obtained in the classification of the individual events, which will be considered as qualification in the team events, and the finals will be governed by the special finals rule.

## ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the I JR CAT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOTGUN.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

**Quotas will be granted for the 2025 Junior Pan American Games in Asunción, PAR.**

## 5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to Barbados Shooting Council Headquarters. Registration forms are provided.

All Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: "Summary of Deadlines").

## Preliminary Entries

CAT Member Federations entering the I JR CAT Championship Shotguns must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **21 JAN 2025**.

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## Final Entries

CAT Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the Barbados Shooting Council Headquarters. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) is **5 FEB 2025**.

## Late Entries

If maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late Entries will only be accepted until the Final Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is **4 MAR 2025**.

Important note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the following changes in the Final Entries are possible without restriction and additional fee:

- Change of names / athletes within an event
  - Change of Status (Championship athlete ↔ “out-of-competition” athlete) within an event.
- Any additional entries received after the Final Entry Deadline, from **5 FEB 2025** onwards, may not participate.

## Entry Changes after the Final Entry Deadline

From **5 FEB 2025** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.
- Change of Status in an event: an “out-of-competition” athlete can replace a withdrawn “Championship” athlete. The withdrawn “Championship” athlete may not shoot “out-of-competition”. The exchange of athletes within an event is not permitted.

## Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of CAT Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

## Cancellation

Any CAT Member Federation reduces the number of entered athletes and / or officials after the Official Entry Deadline (**5 FEB 2025**) is obligated to pay all applicable fees including entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

## Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration and doping control.

The Entry Fees DO NOT include the cost of the Unofficial Trainings in shotguns ranges.

Please transfer all entry fees not later than **5 FEB 2025**.

All payment must be in US\$ and must include any transfer fees or similar fees that the bank may charge. Take care that all necessary data is transferred, so that the Organizing Committee can assign the money to the right federation. Please give a copy of the bank transfer voucher to your head of delegation to take with them.

Every federation will get a preliminary invoice after the Organizing Committee receives the final entry form. All payments made at the shooting range must be paid in cash or may or credit card in US\$ (**US\$ only**) to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

**PLEASE BE AWARE THAT THERE IS NO ATM OR BANK ON THE SHOOTING RANGE OR NEAR BY.**

**Medical Services**

During the competition, the Organizers will provide first aid and paramedical cover. A medical doctor will be in attendance during competition hours.

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## Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the I JR CAT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOTGUN (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

The accreditations (all federations must send a photograph of the athletes together with the registration forms) will be prepared by the Headquarters. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office of the Organizing Committee.

Accreditations and BIB Numbers will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

## 6. Shooting Range

The I JR CAT Championship Shotgun will take place at the Barbados Clay Target Shooting Association.

### Shotgun

The shooting range has 2 combined ranges for Trap/Skeet.

The shooting range is equipped with 15+2 machines and acoustic release system. The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic and manual release system.

All ranges are equipped with electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for the I JR CAT Championship Shotgun are eco-friendly from EUROTARGET, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

## 7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

All nations that need an official invitation from the Barbados Shooting Council, must request it before **21 JAN 2025** (Annex 7). Please send an email to the organizing committee, requesting it.

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be sent by email. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the federation and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

The Barbados Shooting Council has no influence over the embassies.

The Barbados Shooting Council can **ONLY** provide an invitation for the I JR CAT CHAMPIONSHIP SHOTGUN Barbados 2025 period ONLY.

**Note: All fields are mandatory**

### Gun License

All nations must be in possession of the approved arms import form (Annex 8), certified by the Barbados authorities. Be sure to bring a copy of your certified weapon form with you. In addition, it is recommended that all delegations carry a list of all firearms and ammunition, which will be presented to customs agents, upon request, along with the invitation.

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Please fill in the forms completely and do not change the form or use your own form. Incomplete forms cannot be accepted and will be sent back. The completed forms must be submitted to the Organizing Committee by email by **21 JAN 2025** at the latest.

All weapons must be declared, as well as their ammunition. The requirements for the temporary entry of weapons:

- 1.- Fire arms import permit
  - 2.- Event invitation
  - 3.- Passport scanned photo
  - 4.- Photo scanned Gun license
  - 5.- Photo scanned Property card
  6. - In the event that the athlete travels with the weapon of his Federation, he must attach a document of the same.
- The flight itinerary of entry and exit of the country is important.

**IMPORTANT: WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION MUST GO DIRECTLY TO THE ARMORY OF THE SHOOTING RANGE. NO TYPE OF WEAPON OR AMMUNITION CAN BE TRANSFERRED TO THE HOTEL OR OUTSIDE THE SHOOTING RANGE.**

**IT IS IMPORTANT THAT ALL YOUR FIREARMS ARE PRESENTED TO CUSTOMS. IF THERE IS NO OFFICIAL PRESENT WHEN YOU GO THROUGH THE "CUSTOMS AREA", YOU MUST "CONTACT THE ORGANIZING COMMITTEE" AND REQUEST AN OFFICER. IF YOU DO NOT DO SO AND DO NOT SHOW YOUR FIREARMS TO A CUSTOMS OFFICER ENTERING BARBADOS. YOU WILL HAVE PROBLEMS WHEN YOU LEAVE THE COUNTRY AGAIN.**

**Please be sure to submit the completed Firearms Import Permit Applications well in advance before **21 JAN 2025**.**

### Food Service at the Shooting Range

Catering services will be made available at the shooting range at an additional cost.

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## 9. Travel and Transportation (Airport and Local Transportation)

The participating teams will be received by the organizing committee on arrival at Grantley Adams International Airport in Seawell, Christ Church, Barbados. The distance between Grantley Adams International Airport and the area where the official hotels are located is 8.5 km one way and it takes about 15 minutes by car. The transfer between the official hotels and the firing range is 6.8 km and takes 13 minutes on average.

The official pick-up service begins on the Official Arrival Day, which is 7 MAR 2025. Delegations arriving before or leaving after the Official Departure Day of 17 MAR 2025 must make their own arrangements.

The routes included are Airport - Hotel - Airport; and Hotel - Shooting range - Hotel, will cost \$ 120 per athlete.

The organizing committee will only cover a one-way trip to the shooting range and a return trip to the hotel, in case the federations choose to return before the time established by the organizing committee, it will have an additional cost, make the additional transportation arrangements with 24 hours in advance.

Please note that the local bus transport **will ONLY cover the official hotels.**

**THE TRANSPORTATION COST PER ATHLETE IS MANDATORY FOR THE EVENT, IN CASE OF NOT USING THE OFFICIAL HOTEL, THE ATHLETES MUST GO TO THE OFFICIAL HOTELS TO USE THE TRANSPORTATION.**

### Firearm and Ammunition

The armory of the shooting range will provide all the necessary cartridges for training and competition (see the price list below).

**In Barbados, all guns must be stored in the armory at the shooting range. The storage of guns in hotels and outside of the shooting range armory is strictly prohibited.** The armory will be open to facilitate the arrival of official teams until departure.

### Victory Ceremony

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

## 12. Weather Information

### What weather to expect

As we head towards summer, the temperatures pick up a little bit both during the day and night. However, the cooling north-east tradewinds keep things comfortable.

March is typically a very dry month with little rainfall. With 9 hours of sunshine daily, it's the perfect time to visit Barbados.
